Just over one week after the Leaders' Debate, more than 2500 people have voiced their opposition to Howard's claim that apologising to Indigenous Australians is 'offensive to an entire generation'.

Australian Democrats' candidate for Makin, Aleisha Brown created a group using 'facebook' entitled "I won't be offended if the Government says SORRY to Indigenous Australians".

"I've had an amazing response to the group, the current total is around 2500 people," Ms Brown said.

"Clearly there is a lot more to be done beyond offering an apology, but it would certainly set the way to make real ground on the issue of reconciliation, said Ms Brown."
